Thanks to your generosity, over 200 families living on the edge of Phnom Penh Cambodia's flooded sanitation dumps, unable to work because of Covid, were given sustained relief with food and care this year. In India, over 25 wells were dug in villages without water, poverty stricken children were sent to school, an orphanage was rescued, and 50 children kept from going back on the street. Funds are being received to care for 600 children separated or orphaned by the war in Ethiopia where our beloved Gabe Beyene weeps, prays and spreads hope. We love and pray for China, too. As the world changes, we are developing plans for even deeper involvement and support for East Asia. This really touches only the highlights.

Mission Cambodia

James Saan, our representative in Cambodia, is pictured below with members of a family living in the “New Garbage Slum” in Phnom Penh. Here’s how James describes life there:

The families, both parents and children, who are living there are surviving by picking up the trash to sell. So they usually go out to pick up the trash for 12 to 14 hours. Each family can earn 3.50 to 5 USD per day from selling the recycled trash. In average, each family has 3 to 5 children. Unfortunately, the food is very expensive in the Cambodia and is not enough for them to survive together. As the result, the parents are unable to send their children to school because they need to have pay for the children’s uniform, food, transportation. They even have to pay their small temporarily rental wreckage house. Their life has no goal and full of hopeless.

Thanks to your support, James and his team are able to bring food, love and hygiene supplies to these families. They also share snacks and small gifts with the children in the dump. James reports his goals as

- 1) To ease the hard life of those poor people who are living in the slum community through our small gifts.
- 2) To show God’s love to both Christians and Buddhists through our love for them.

In India, 200,000 People Die Each Year Through Unsafe Water



All around Kakinada, where we focus our attention through the compassionate ministry of Paparao Yelchuri, there are literally hundreds of villages, pockets of people living in thatch houses but without a well or clean water. Women and girls have to walk long distances to murky ponds or wormy wells.

Can you imagine the joy and celebration when Partners in Hope provides them a well right in the center of their village? The opening of those wells is nothing short of a holiday. A part of the ceremony is large numbers of the women and children eagerly lining up to receive a prayer of blessing and thanksgiving.

A new well costs around \$650 USD.

100 Year-Old Orphanage in India Closing for Lack of Funds! 50 Children Without Homes.

No, it doesn't have to happen: The good news is our Partners in Hope rallied and we raised the funds to keep the orphanage going for the rest of the year. It won't take much from all of us to keep it going from now on. Your partnership with Children's Hope makes the difference.

From Pastor Paparao - July 11, 2021 Two days ago, I have visited an orphanage where there are 26 girls and 24 boys aged about 4 to 12 years old are living. These children are orphans or from seriously impoverished families. Due to Covid 19, the orphanage has lost its funding and the children will be put on the street. These children are literally crying as the orphanage is going to be closed. They are praying morning and evening for the help to come to them so that they can stay in the orphanage. By seeing their tears, I too cried to God and spent time with them in prayer - asking God to open the doors of heaven for His helping hands for this orphanage. I cannot see the suffering and fear of these children. Once if these girls go to the streets again to beg for food, these girls will be spoiled and sold away to the brothel homes and the boys will be trained up to do robbery. I want these children to stay in the orphanage - in the Light of God. I am just praying for His helping hands to come for these little children. We need your prayers and your compassion for these little ones. Thank you very much for your kindness.
